

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, IOWA, 1999 BY AMENDING THE CHAPTER PROVIDING A DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AND DEER MANAGEMENT ZONE IN CHAPTER 58 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, IOWA:**

**Section 1. Section Modified.** Chapter 58 Subsections .02 and .03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Clinton, Iowa, 1999 are repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

58.02 DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM. Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 461C.8 (2006), the City of Clinton, Iowa adopts an ordinance authorizing trained, volunteer hunters to hunt deer with a bow and arrow within the municipality, without charge, for the purpose of urban deer control. The City of Clinton Deer Management Committee has determined that deer management within the corporate limits is a necessary duty of the City to ensure that the health of the herd is maintained, that plant and animal life which make up the ecosystems of the natural areas of the City are not irreparably damaged or destroyed, and to ensure the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City and prevent major damage to their property by deer. Said Committee has developed a Deer Management Program, which is attached to Ordinance Number \_\_\_\_\_ and hereby adopted in full and made a part hereof by reference. A copy of said program is on file in the office of the City Clerk.

58.03 DEER MANAGEMENT ZONE. The City of Clinton Deer Management Committee has determined that the Deer Management Zone is defined as the area inside the following boundaries:

Starting at the intersection of Highway 30 and Mill Creek Parkway. Proceeding north on Mill Creek Parkway to 16<sup>th</sup> Street North West. North on 16<sup>th</sup> Street North West to Main Avenue. East on Main Avenue to West Stockwell Lane. North on West Stockwell Lane, then East on North Stockwell Lane to Highway 67. North on Highway 67 to Deer Creek Road. East on East Deer Creek Road to the Mississippi River. Proceeding south along the riverbank to 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue North. West on 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue North to North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. South on North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue North. West on 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue North to North 4<sup>th</sup> Street. South on North 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue North. West on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue North then proceeding along Bluff Boulevard to South 14<sup>th</sup> Street. South on South 14<sup>th</sup> Street to

Highway 30. Then west on Highway 30 to the intersection of Mill Creek Parkway.

Said described area is represented by a map appended to Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_, on file in the office of the City Clerk, and made a part hereof by reference.

**Section 2. Severability Clause.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid of unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 3. Repealer.** Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 4. When Effective.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
